An Intermission Treat for the Diminutive Theatergoer

The new musical "A Year With Frog and Toad," at the Cort Theater, features a song about chocolate chip cookies. Figuring that the audience, mostly the young set, might be in the mood for a cookie at intermission, the producers turned to Geoff & Drew's Incredible Cookies, a Boston company, to package a cookie especially for the show. It is a large chocolate chunk cookie, on the crisp side,
